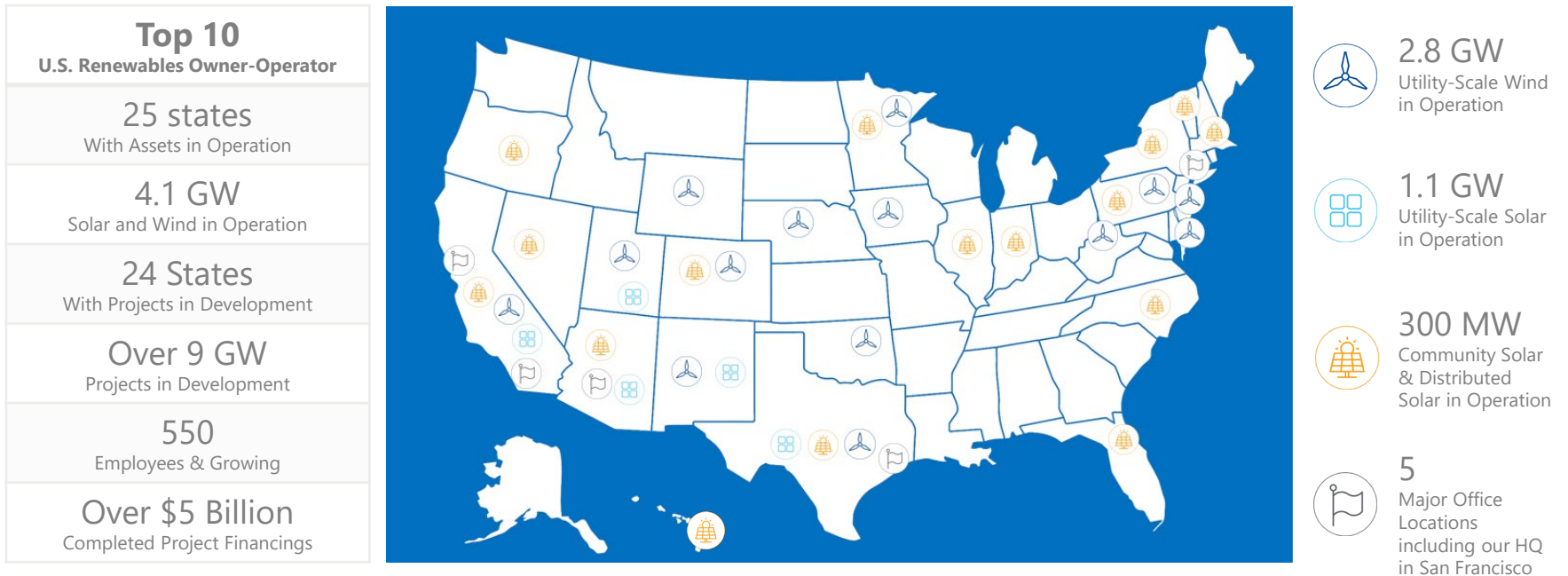

Who We Are: Clearway is one of the largest renewable energy companies in the United States.

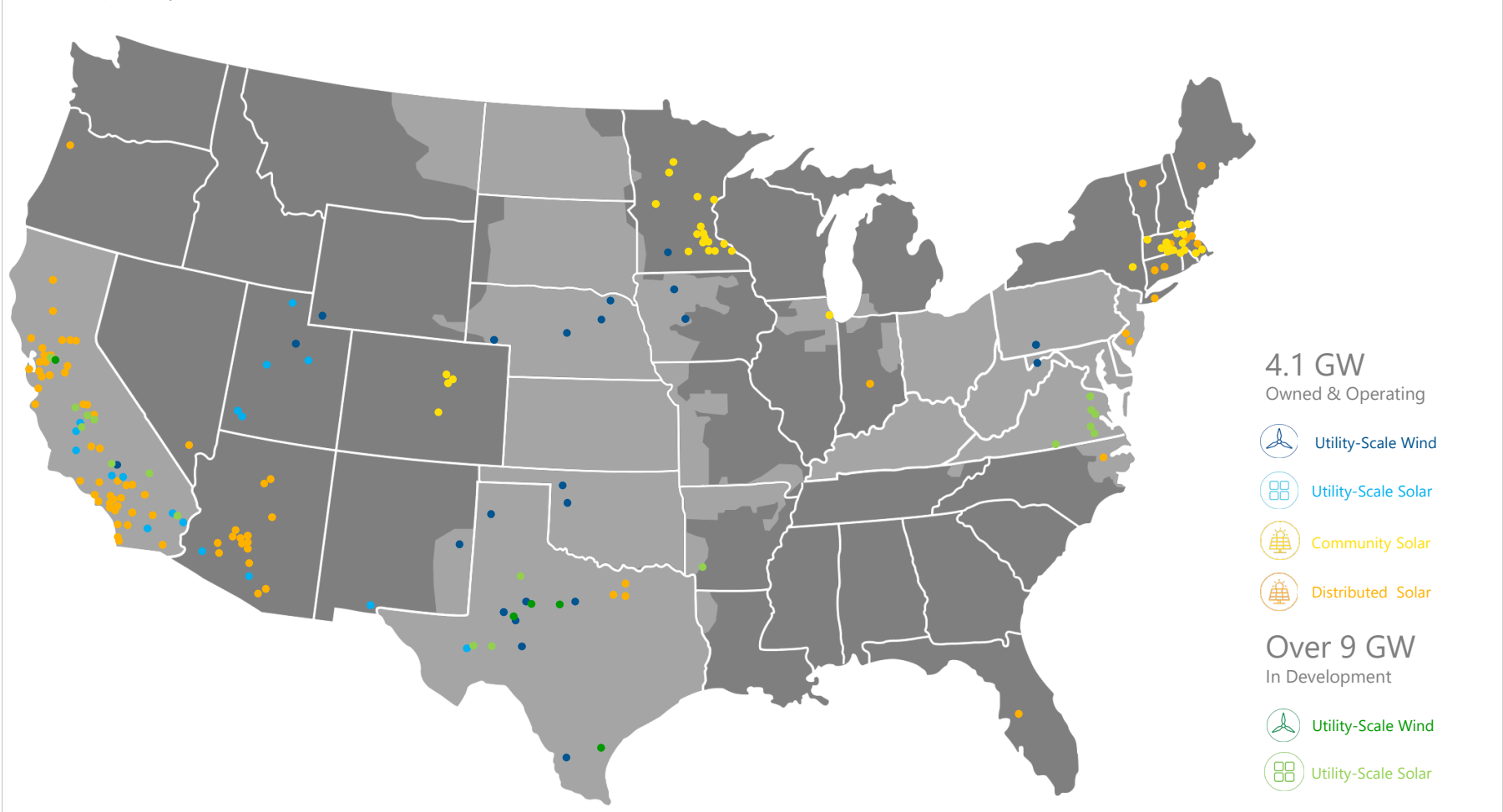


What We Do: Clearway participates in every stage of the life-cycle of our projects: from origination and development – through construction and financing – to ownership, management, and operations.

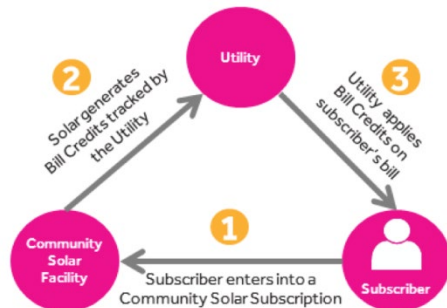
Clearway's 2 Main Businesses:

COMMUNITY SOLAR

Clearway is the largest owner-operator of Community Solar in the US.

Clearway owns community solar projects in all of the major community solar markets that allow 3rd party ownership including CO, IL, MA, MN, NY.

Clearway has 8.9 GW of wind and solar projects under development in regulated and RTO markets across the US including: CAISO, PJM, ERCOT, MISO, and more.
